**Dear Brothers and Sisters of St. Michael's,**

*Lent lies at the very heart of our Catholic faith. Each year, on Ash Wednesday, we begin our Lenten retreat. We are blessed with ashes, reminding us that we are dust, and to dust we will return. For the next 40 days we are led into the desert of our own hearts to look within, face our sins, and ask for God's mercy.*

*While Lent was originally intended as a time of preparation for those being baptised at Easter, it gradually became a time when all of us get ready to renew our own baptismal promises. It is the season in which we prepare both individually and as a Church for the Second Coming of our Lord and Savior. It is the season when we reflect on the dying and rising of Christ that has made our salvation possible. Even more than that, it is the season when we enter into Christ's dying and rising as we seek to purify, cleanse, and nourish our bodies, minds and souls.*

*Lent is a time of sacrifice and discipline, but it should not be a time of sadness. Instead it should be a season of great joy. The first Preface for the Mass in Lent clearly reminds us of this....For by your gracious gift each year your faithful await the sacred paschal feasts with the joy of minds made pure. So, as Christians we are stirring up our faith and love for God and each other so that, on Easter, we are ready to meet the risen Lord refreshed and restored.*

*We hear in passing of people who talk about how "I will never forgive, never talk to .... Again". I ask you to seek the Lord in order to forgive. Pray for the person who offended you and for God to help bring peace between you both. Most importantly reach out to the person who offended you and forgive them. If you are aware of something you have done to harm others ....Go to confession, pray for the person you offended and ask for God to help bring peace between you both. Then reach out for this person you have offended and ask them for forgiveness. The feeling of peace and love you will feel is indescribable from head to toe.*

We imagine that the best Lent is one in which we enter the season with our whole heart, we must focus our intentions and concentrate on our spiritual goals. We all know truthfully of ourselves the sins of our souls we must admit in confession and carry on life without the repeat of these sins that drain our minds by being part of our character and, that they were in my character to begin with. The cleansing of my soul from making my confession is the most enlightening thing that could happen to anyone in their life. The complete cleansing of our soul over the devil.

To continue a healthy spiritual life after confession avoid the seven deadly sins:  
**PRIDE:** an excessive love of self or the desire to be better or more important than others.  
**LUST:** an intense desire, usually for sexual pleasure, but also for money, power or fame.  
**GLUTTONY:** over-consumption, usually of food or drink.  
**GREED:** the desire for and love of possessions.  
**SLOTH:** physical laziness, also disinterest in spiritual matters or neglecting spiritual growth.  
**ANGER OR WRATH:** uncontrolled feelings of hatred or rage.  
**ENVY AND JEALOUSY:** sadness or desire for the possessions, happiness, talents, or abilities of another.

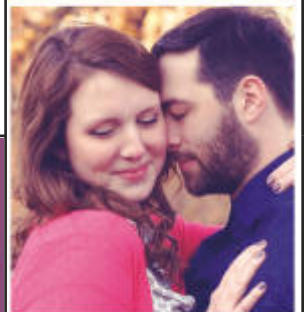
