**Brothers and Sisters of St. Michael's,**

In the Gospel (John 3:14-21), we heard that “God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.” This is why the crucifix is supposed to be in the sanctuary of every Catholic Church throughout the world. It is the sign of God’s great love for us, despite our sinfulness. God does not promise days without pain, laughter without sorrow, sun without rain, but he does promise strength for the day, comfort for the tears, and light for the way.

In his message Saint Paul said to God, who is rich in mercy, because of the great love he had for us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, brought us to life with Christ... by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not from you; it is the gift of God...” Does this mean that obedience to God’s Law – all those Do’s and Don’ts – is unimportant? Of course not! God’s Law instructs us on how we are to respond to the free gift of God’s love. It is out of God’s great love for us that he has given us his Law that we might live in a way that honors and glorifies him.

Jesus, who hangs on the Cross to show us God’s love, has stated “I am the light of the world.” Jesus tells us that our eternal destiny is being determined, even now, by how we react to his light: “Everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come toward the light, so that his works might not be exposed. But, whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that his works might be clearly seen as done in God.” Are you walking in the light of Jesus love? Or do you fear his light because of what it might reveal in the dark corners of your life that you try to keep hidden? Jesus invites us to step into his light, seek his forgiveness for the sins that are illuminated by his truth and goodness, and live as true children of God for that is what we are. The eternal destiny of each of us is being determined by our response to the light, and love, of Jesus Christ. He is waiting for your response, right now.

During this most Holy Season which is upon us, our parish is giving us a chance to see the light, the light of forgiveness. We have arranged for Confession in three languages coming to our Church this week. Would it not be a wonderful gift to yourself and to God for you to step into the light of forgiveness and confess your sins enabling you to walk in the light instead of the darkness of sin. I pray that I see you at confession this week, to be able to see your cleansed soul walking in the light of our Lord, full of His forgiveness. God is great and so is the feeling of the forgiveness of our Lord.

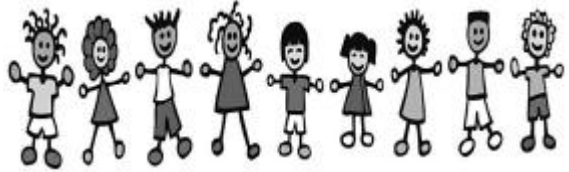

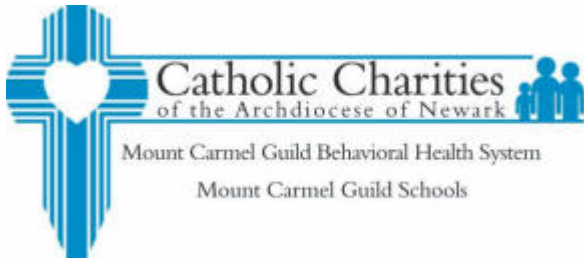


